



## 1.7 Establishing Tracking Platform to Monitor Shipping Dynamics in Real-Time

To meet production needs and monitor the delivery schedule of imported raw materials in real-time, CSAC introduced digital tools and completed the establishment of a real-time tracking platform for shipping dynamics, material tracking platform, and resource sharing e-platform in May 2024. Through digital systems, relevant departments can improve operational efficiency and responsiveness.

## 1.8 Successfully passed the re-certification audit of Authorized Economic Operator (AEO)

In order to comply with the international trade supply chain security systems and respond to the Customs Administration's promotion of the Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) policy, CSAC successfully passed the Customs Administration's AEO center review for the first time in June 2012, becoming a qualified AEO operator. After a three-year validation period, CSAC successfully passed the review on June 21, 2024, obtaining the AEO extension certificate, fully demonstrating the company's excellent internal security control capabilities.

AEO is a certification system that advocates the safety of cross-border cargo movement. After certification, companies can enjoy preferential measures such as pre-release of import/export goods, minimal document review, low cargo inspection rates, and non-intrusive inspection methods according to the "Quality Enterprise Certification and Management Measures." Taiwan has signed mutual recognition agreements (MRA) with countries such as the United States, South Korea, Australia, Japan, and Canada, and has implemented cross-strait customs AEO mutual recognition pilot projects with China. Certified AEO companies will enjoy faster and more convenient customs clearance measures in countries implementing AEO mutual recognition cooperation.
